Instructions for the Preparation of a Poster Presentation

Instructions for Authors

These notes are to help authors prepare a poster for presentation in the International Conference on Integrated Water Resources Management, 12-13 October 2011, Dresden, Germany.

Posters will be displayed in the poster gallery at the Conference venue, according to the schedule announced by organizers. Authors should produce a visual representation of the poster so it can be readily displayed on the poster supports provided.

- **1. Objective.** A poster should be a visual representation of reviewed material, which can initiate an informal discussion.
- **2. Size.** Posters should be in format DIN A 0 upright size (84,1 x 118,9 cm)
- 3. Layout and Style. The poster basic elements are similar to those of a regular paper:
 - 1. **Title**: The title of the poster should include author's names, affiliations and email address'.
 - 2. **Introduction**: The poster should include a brief section devoted to an introduction of the work conducted.
 - 3. **Objectives**: The poster should include a section describing the main and specific objectives of the work conducted.
 - 4. **Results and discussion**: The poster should include a section devoted to describing, presenting and discussing the results obtained; it may be necessary to also include a section devoted to the materials and methods adopted.
 - 5. **Conclusions:** The poster should finish with a series of brief and concise conclusions and recommendations.
 - 6. **Flow:** The flow of the poster content should be clear and logical. Individual sections should be numbered.
- **4. Handouts.** Ideally a one-page handout with an overview of the poster and contact details should be available to interested visitors.
- **5. Author(s):** your contact details (i.e. business card) should be available to interested visitors.
- **6. Register of Interest.** Authors should provide a sheet of paper for people whom would like further details to leave contact details.

7. Presentation. At least one author of the poster should be present at the Conference. Presenters should bring their posters with them to the Conference. Posters are to be set up and dismantled by authors at an allotted time; materials will be available for you to do this.
